

Flow Steps to Successful On-Lot Sewage Management Program (SMP) Compliance

MUST COMPLETE BOTH EVERY 3 YEARS BY **October 31st**



Your SMP Routine Inspection is due every 3 years

SMP INSPECTION

Check the date of your previous inspection, new system installation or program's waiver previously granted.

Add 3 years – that's the year your SMP inspection is due!

Find a Pennsylvania Septage Management Association (PSMA) certified inspector and schedule your SMP inspection
www.pasma.net

Ensure the inspector fills out an **SMP Routine Inspection Report** (available online) during the inspection

Submit a completed inspection report and copies of your pumping receipts to the Township by October 31st of the year you are due.

Your **MUST** pump your system at least once every 3 years

SYSTEM PUMPING

Check the date of your last pumping and determine your next pumping service*

*A **maximum 3-year pumping interval** is the accepted standard in Pennsylvania, unless you have a very large family, an undersized tank, or a garbage disposal.

Hire a Chester County Health Department licensed Liquid Waste Hauler to perform pumping at least once every 3 years OR as recommended
