How to Engage in the Public Comment Sections of a Township Meeting

Public Comment is heard at three (3) different points during the meeting:

- 1. BEFORE OLD BUSINESS The public is permitted to make public comment on any matter not on the agenda. This comment period is subject to the time constraint in (d) below
- 2. PRIOR TO any action on a motion on an Agenda item. Public Comment at this stage is limited to the item under discussion (e.g. it is not appropriate to initiate a discussion on police services if the body is acting upon a sewer issue).
- 3. AFTER NEW BUSINESS. Public Comment is open to any legitimate item of business which can be considered by that Township Board/Commission (e.g. Planning Commission can discuss issues having to do with plan reviews, but cannot discuss why the Township does not plow your street sooner. Supervisors can discuss nearly every issue).

How to make a comment to any Township Board/Commission:

- a. The Chair will announce that the Board/Commission will now hear public comment, either on a specific issue or generally.
- b. You must then obtain recognition from the Chair prior to speaking.
- c. Once you have the floor, state your name and address for the record.
- d. You may then make your comment or ask your question. You will have three (3) minutes to make your statement, unless the Chair has announced otherwise, so please come prepared!

Dear Mr. Pingar:

As requested, McCormick Taylor has received and reviewed the bids for the Westtown Township 2018 Road Maintenance Program. The bidding began on June 14, 2018 and bids were received, opened, and reviewed on June 28, 2018 at 10:00 am. The bids were advertised on June 14, 2018 and June 18, 2018 in the Daily Local Newspaper.

This project was originally received and reviewed on May 2, 2018. The project was awarded to Innovative Construction Services, Inc. at the May 7, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting. However, the project was not advertised in the Daily Local Newspaper, which is a requirement by the State of Pennsylvania. Therefore, the original bid could not be awarded, and rebid was required due to a procedural error in the bidding process.

Bid Tabulation Summary

Below is summary of the Westtown Township 2018 Road Maintenance Program bids received (Full Bid Tabulation Attached):

Recommendation of Award

- Based on the bids provided for the Westtown Township 2018 Road Maintenance Program, the Township budget, and bid analysis <u>Glasgow, Inc.</u> is the lowest responsible bidder with a Base Bid of \$670,004.65 and an Add Alt Total (1-4) of \$263,957.80 for a total bid of \$933,962.45.
- Based on the Township budget, it is recommended that <u>Glasgow, Inc.</u> be awarded a total bid award of \$803,350.20 consisting of the Base Bid of \$670,004.65 and Add Alternates 2, 3, and 4 having a value of \$133,345.55.
- o For reference purposes, <u>Innovative Construction Services</u>, <u>Inc. (INNCON)</u> was the original lowest responsible bidder with a Base Bid of \$664,922.58 and an Add Alt Total (1-4) of \$256,770.90 for a total bid of \$921,693.48. Based on Township budget, <u>Innovative Construction Services</u>, <u>Inc. (INNCON)</u> was awarded the Base Bid of \$664,922.58 and Add Alternates 2, 3, and 4 having a value of \$117,030.85 for a total bid award of \$781,953.43. This is a difference of \$21,396.77 from the new recommendation of award.

PROCESS

In order for the contract to be executed, the selected Contractor must provide all Contract Documents listed in the bid package. As part of the bid, Glasgow, Inc. submitted an executed Proposal and Contract (PennDOT Form MS-944), and Special Provisions to Contract MS-944 (Attachment 1-A). Original, signed hard copies of these documents must be provided to the Township for execution.

Additionally, the contractor must provide the following Contract Documents: Performance Bond, Payment Bond, Certificate of Insurance, Finalized Construction Schedule including key milestone dates, Approved PennDOT Material Supplier, Pavement Mix Designs (2018 approved), Public Works Employment Verification Form (Act 127), and a copy of the Notice to Property owners.

Following confirmation of award from the Board of Supervisors (BOS), McCormick Taylor will notify the PennDOT Municipal Services Representative that the contract was awarded and supply all necessary paperwork associated with Liquid Fuels reimbursement.
