Emergency Response Improvement Efforts

Pipeline operators are working together to improve pipeline emergency response capabilities. The API-AOPL Emergency Response Team (ERT) is made up of emergency response managers and personnel from a broad cross section of major North American liquids pipeline operators. Through the ERT, pipeline operators are:

- 1) Listening to and learning from first responders on how to improve emergency response capabilities
- 2) Reaching out to first responders in the fire, law enforcement and emergency communities with pipeline specific information
- 3) Improving pipeline operator capabilities through new emergency response recommended practices,
- 4) Assisting first responders with free, online pipeline emergency response training.
