Re: Recreation Programming Survey Summary

I have summarized key points from the first recreation programming survey below. As with any survey, there are inherent issues that can complicate interpretation of the results such as survey design, data entry, and non-response bias.

Response:

318 respondents (6 nonresident), adjusted for those who did not proceed past the first question (residency).

Visitation at Oakbourne Park:

51% visit 1-5 times/month 9% visit 6-10 times/month 34% don't visit Oakbourne

Communication:

The vast majority of respondents ranked email as the preferred method of Township communication (227). Other methods of communication (direct mail, website, and social media) were fairly evenly preferred.

Demographics:

56% of respondents have one to three members of their household over age 55 82% have at least one child under age 18

Types of programs residents are interested in:

Adult recreation (e.g. yoga, dance, bird watching) - 57%
Adult sports - 51%
Educational (e.g. lectures, how-to, technology) - 51%
Social activities (e.g. bus trips, card games, book club) - 50%
Youth sports - 36%
Youth after school or summer camp - 25%

Comments and Concerns:

The majority of respondents who took the time to make program suggestions or express comments indicated a desire for more walking trails/nature programs such as interpretive walks, plant identification, bird watching, stream study (21). The desire for affordable summer camps/kids activities was the next most mentioned (19). Bus trips was the next most mentioned (5).

Areas of concern expressed by multiple respondents include:

- pickleball noise
- facilities scheduling
- destroying the natural beauty of Oakbourne Park
- use of park facilities by nonresidents
- other townships have better recreation offerings than Westtown

Conclusion:

The survey indicates a desire for adult recreation offerings. A follow-up survey is recommended to hone in on what our older residents would prefer.
